

# Shate your story! ALUMNI PRESENTATIONS



Hello Verto Alumni Community! Name I'm Neal Crosson, I work on Verto's Admissions Team, and I've prepared this guide to help you share your Verto story with your high school. As an alum, you have an amazing story to share—and students want to hear it!

You may also inspire the next generation to join the Verto Community. Pay it forward by sharing this opportunity with your home community.

Below is a simple way to set up a presentation at your former high school. You can email me at <a href="mailto:neal.crosson@vertoeducation.org">neal.crosson@vertoeducation.org</a> with any questions, ideas, or request for support!

- 1. **Summarize your story.** Start by asking yourself a few questions.
  - a. Who are you? Why did you decide to study abroad with Verto?
  - b. Where did you study abroad? What made you decide on that location?
  - c. What did you do during your time abroad?
  - d. What were some of your favorite moments? Most memorable experiences?
  - e. What did you learn about yourself? How did your experiences shape or change you?
- Identify your contact at your former high school: The best people to contact are going to be those that you have a personal relationship with. Think teachers, counselors, administrators, etc.
- 3. **Set up a plan for outreach:** Depending on how well you know this person, give them a call or email asking them to present. Use the email template below!
- 4. **Day of the event!** This is the fun part. Use this <u>slide deck</u> as a template. Go out there and share your story!
- 5. **Let me know how your visit went!** Send me an email(<u>neal.crosson@vertoeducation.org</u>) and give a brief summary. How did it go? Highlights? Challenges?

### **Templates for Communication**

### **Example call:**

- Introduce yourself: Hi [counselor]! This is Neal, I was a student at [high school] and I graduated last year.
- Give context: This is your opportunity to talk about your Verto experience. How has it impacted your life? Why do you want to share it with this school/other students?
- Create an action plan: What do you want to happen? A visit? A presentation? When?
