What to Look Forward to:

- Making New Friends: Get to know your Care Team, peers, and Verto community through activities, excursions, meals, and more.
- A Welcome Event: This typically involves delicious food, socializing, and music.
- Venturing Out Together: Find out what's in your neighborhood, get your SIM card, and get oriented! Whether it's discovering your new favorite coffee shop, figuring out how to use public transit, or learning basic phrases in your host language, this week is all about settling in and learning how to navigate your host city.
- **Goal Setting:** What do you want to achieve? How will you get involved? This is a week to reflect on how you want to show up for yourself and the Verto community.
- Topical Workshops:
 - Academics: From study skills and academic support, to policies and expectations, you'll delve into all of the must-know information to set you up for success in your coursework.
 - Health & Safety: Learn how to access local medical care, use your CISI insurance, how and when to use the 24/7 emergency phone number, and local laws you need to be aware of, among other topics.
 - **Housing:** Learn the ins and outs of your home away from home, including how to do laundry, file a maintenance request if something is broken, go grocery shopping (and cook if applicable), live with roommates, and more.
 - Community: Building community is at the center of any Verto experience.
 You'll learn how to make the community yours through leading or joining student clubs, signing up for community events, volunteer activities, and other opportunities to get involved!
